Top 10 Safety Rules:

- 1. **Lock your door:** Do it every time, no matter how quickly you are returning. Never prop a door.
- 2. Travel in groups at night: Be aware of who and what is around you.
- 3. **Avoid Isolated areas:** Travel well-used and well-lit areas.
- 4. Park in well-lit, busy areas: Don't leave valuables in your car.
- 5. Do not use ATMs at night: Plan ahead and do your banking during daylight.
- 6. Never ride with strangers: Be familiar with campus and city bus services.
- 7. **Do not leave belongings unattended:** Keep up with your stuff in the dorm, library, study rooms, classrooms,-everywhere, at all times.
- 8. Know your location: Report crimes or other suspicious circumstances immediately.
- 9. **Know your limits with alcohol and social situations:** Things can change quickly, especially in a party atmosphere. It's easy to find yourself in a situation you are not comfortable with.
- 10. **Tell someone where you are going:** Let someone you can count on know where you are going, who you will be with and when you expect to be home from a date or any other evening out.
